## 1. RULES OF THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES

The following rules are supplementary to the rules contained in the Calendar of the Central University of Technology, Free State (CUT).

### GENERAL

A list of prescribed textbooks for the different learning programmes is issued on enrolment.

**A student may only follow the second-, third- or fourth-year level of study on condition that the first-, second- or third-year level respectively has been successfully completed.**

A diploma programme may not be completed in less than three years, unless the student has been awarded exemption or recognition for at least four instructional offerings. Under such circumstances, the diploma programme may not be completed in less than two years.

Students must participate in all scheduled assessments. In the event of absence for a valid reason, it is the student's responsibility to arrange with the relevant lecturer and/or the Assessment and Graduation Unit for a special assessment session, or risk being penalised. The Assessment Manual for 2013 gives comprehensive information regarding the assessment process.

Students may be expected to attend certain lectures in the evening or on a block basis over weekends.

**Official and complete admission requirements are contained in chapter 5 of the CUT Calendar. Admission requirements reflected in the learning programme part of the Calendar are sometimes only a summarised version thereof.**

On successful completion of his/her studies, the graduate is expected to possess those professional attributes and competencies to qualify for a position of responsible leadership. The MEd programme may be pursued in the field of education only.

A candidate seeking to pursue the Master of Education Degree (Research) is to submit a letter of application for admission to the Director of the School of Teacher Education, via the Head of Department, before completing the relevant application forms of CUT. The applicant to this degree programme must:

1. Hold a BEd (Hons) degree or an Education related honours degree with a professional teaching qualification from an accredited university;
2. Have an average pass rate of 60% or above at BEd (Hons) level;
3. Have passed the subject Research Methodology at BEd (Hons) level with a minimum of 65% (the content of the Research Methodology course will be evaluated);
4. Submit copies of official transcripts of all previous undergraduate and graduate work, for verification of the candidate's scholarly performance;
5. Submit at least two letters of recommendation from previous lecturers/professors who can attest to the candidate's promise as a postgraduate student;
6. Submit a detailed statement of professional goals; and
7. Submit a research proposal.

A candidate may apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), and in this case is required to submit a portfolio as determined by the School of Teacher Education.

- RPL equivalent. Evidence of applied competence is to be assessed by a team of suitably qualified and experienced practitioners on the basis of at least a written report, which should include a portfolio to prove educational research experience at the required level, as well as oral defence of such report.

**Exit-level outcomes**

The researcher is able to demonstrate the ability to carry out advanced research at the highest level within complex and often unpredictable contexts on particular aspects of education, culminating in a research thesis.

**GENERAL RULES FOR DOCTORAL DEGREES.****Admission (Rule G34)**

1. A student seeking admission to a Doctoral Degree must be in possession of a Master's Degree in the faculty in which he/she wishes to study, except if otherwise approved by Senate. The student must also submit proof thereof and have satisfied Senate as to his/her proficiency in the proposed field of study.
2. Before a student's application for registration can be finalised, the title or topic of his/her proposed thesis must be submitted to Senate for approval.

**Duration of study (*Rule G35*)**

1. The degree may be conferred on a candidate if he/she was registered for that degree at CUT for at least two academic years.
2. The maximum period of study is four years. An extension may be granted by Senate only in exceptional circumstances and on submission of a motivated application, as well as a recommendation by the Head of Department concerned.
